### NOTICE TO AIRPORT CONSULTANTS

DBE firms are encouraged to apply. All proposals received will be evaluated based on FAA Advisory Circular 150/5100-14D and on compliance with the request.

Grand County, Colorado is soliciting Statements of Qualifications and Experience from consulting firms to provide professional airport engineering services for the Granby-Grand County Airport in Granby, CO. for up to a five-year period beginning on the date the Consultant signs the Engineering Agreement Attachment for the first Federally funded Project. All projects will depend upon available funding from various sources, which may include the FAA, the State of Colorado and Grand County. No project listed is guaranteed to take place under the time-frame of this contract. The selected consultant will provide engineering and other services for potential projects that may include:

- Snow Removal/Equipment
- Snow Removal Equipment Building
- Pavement Preservation
- Construct Hangar Taxilanes / Apron
- Fencing and Access Gates
- Construct Parallel Taxiway
- AWOS
- ALP Update
- Environmental Studies
- Construct Runway and/or Taxiway Lighting, Signage and Visual Aids
- Upgrade/Relocate Fuel Farm

Services to be provided and selection processes are outlined in FAA Advisory Circular 150/5100-14D. Services required include, but are not limited to, A/E services for all phases and necessary incidental services for projects funded by FAA grants within five (5) years subject to review on an annual basis. Selection criteria will include: capability to perform all aspects of project, reputation, ability to meet schedules within budget; quality of previous airport projects undertaken, familiarity with the project location, understanding of the airport and proposed projects, and approach to proposed projects.

This contract is subject to the provisions of Executive Order 11246 (Affirmative Action to Ensure Equal Employment Opportunity) and to the provisions of the Department of Transportation Regulations 49 CFR Part 26 (Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Participation). The consultant or subcontractor, by submission of an offer and/or execution of a contract, certifies that it:

- A. is not owned or controlled by one or more citizens or nationals of a foreign country included in the list of countries that discriminate against U.S. firms published by the Office of the United States Trade Representative (USTR);
- B. has not knowingly entered into any contract or subcontract for this project with a contractor that is a citizen or national of a foreign country on said list, or is owned or controlled directly or indirectly by one or more citizens or nationals of a foreign country on said list;
- C. has not procured any product nor subcontracted for the supply of any product for use on the project that is produced in a foreign country on said list.
